Reminder: Monthly expenses cover:

1. Transport (Transport is now simplified, low risk on commercial transport and I can now travel on timely basis after acquiring an automobile. I will to secure sufficient funds for fueling the automobile).
 - a) to preach in Jinja, Tororo and Kampala,
 - b) to transport destitute Christians to church for worship
 - c) to transport children to school
2. Church rent, lighting and water.
3. Family needs:
 - a) Food for the family
 - b) Others (medications, clothing, house help, toiletry, etc)
4. Utilities: (Electricity (revised), water, postal services, communication, others),
5. School fees and scholastic materials paid in: January, April and August,
6. Helps to destitute brethren during emergencies. One brother was last Sunday knocked down by a car, still in Jinja hospital, medical bill now is \$150 to pay.

I am very thankful for the way brethren have opened their hearts form us in Uganda. May God richly bless all those are supporting us. We are praying for all those are sending us support.
